Followed in 2024 by the South Africa Dialogue, an international annual event primarily for African leaders to build on the work of PACCA and identify and adopt integrated and coordinated Pan-African strategies for combatting corruption

Following on from the South Africa Dialogue, SARCOE organises National Conversations in participating countries, leading to National Counter-Corruption Summits on resolving corruption based on the annually updated frameworks agreed at the South Africa Dialogue

Provides Africa with an independent professional resource to improve the rule of law, promote integrity and transparency, and address corruption and AML/CFT issues.

Directed towards improving the capacity and capabilities of law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, judges, compliance officers and others professionals from the private and public sectors working to counter corruption and improve compliance

Provides highly practical short courses to professionals in how to:

- Combat corruption
 - Promote integrity and compliance
 - Enhance the rule of law

All courses:

- Enhance the capabilities of those attending;
- Are taught by leading experts in their fields from the Pavocat-Stellenbosch Academy; and
- Are fully accredited by Stellenbosch University.

Will be administered and run, via SARCOE, by the Pavocat-Stellenbosch Academy Will place South Africa in the vanguard of efforts to preserve, improve and strengthen countercorruption architecture across Africa, thereby enhancing its international reputation

Inspired by the success of **Davos** (the World Economic Forum) and the Manama Dialogue in Bahrain (the Middle East's leading security conference attended annually by world leaders), The South Africa Dialogue will be Africa's Annual Premier Summit on Countering Corruption on the Continent
